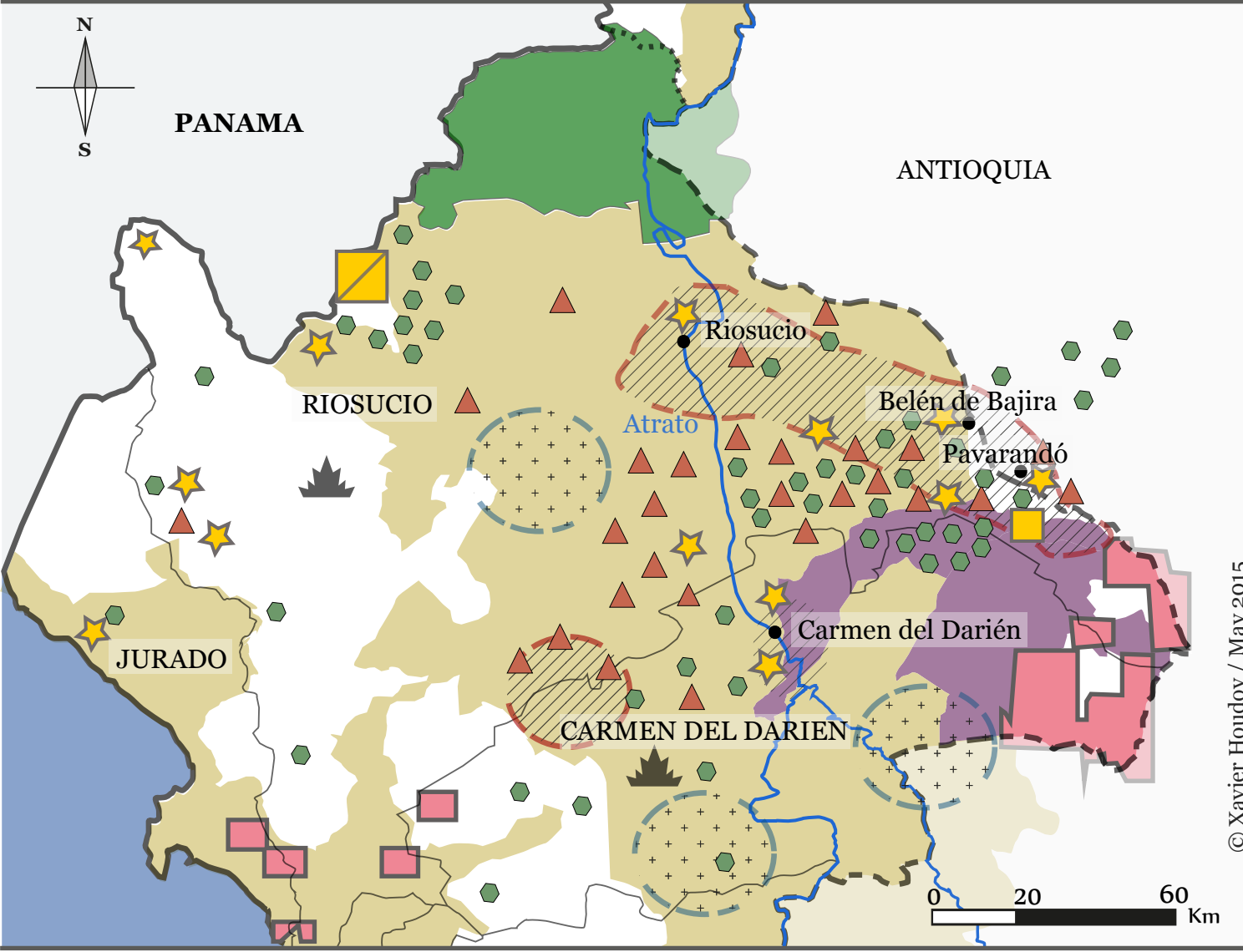


ACTORS AND PROCESSES OF INCREASED TERRITORIAL PRESSURE IN BAJO ATRATO
