

Call for Contributions – Paper Series (MENA)

Over the coming months, Noria Research will launch a new paper series focused on the geopolitical and geoeconomic fallout of the American-Israeli war on Iran. The paper series retains no particular geographic focus. However, studies on the MENA region are especially welcome.

While editors are open to pitches, proposals aligning with one or more of the following thematics have the highest likelihood of being commissioned:

- Interstate relations: diplomatic and military alignments/tensions brought on by war
- The outlook for key non-state actors
- Defense industry developments
- The energy channel: effects on the sourcing of oil & gas and on the deployment of renewables.
- Impacts on investment and trade flows
- Macroeconomic consequence & downstream social risks
- Impacts on cross-border labor movements

The call is open to researchers and investigators of all backgrounds: academics, graduate students, journalists, industry professionals, civil society actors. In keeping with one of our institutional mandates, Noria editors will give preference to proposals from early-career professionals. Proposals from contributors based in locations under study will also receive preferential treatment in the commissioning process.
